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

After asking what size they were and having to look at the back tag and admiring my underwear, our conversation was fully underway. With a built-in stretch, the pants are so comfortable I wore them every other day with different tops. My favourite feature is the versatility to make into capris length, without the usual roll up snap or button; there is a draw cord on the inside of the leg pocket that cinches up the side of the leg up for a fabulous stylish look while providing a custom fit. The stone color I wore perfectly accented the carbon color of the KÜHL trench coat I also own for a comfortable, good-looking travel look. It is the first time I have traveled and felt really stylish and happy with the outer gear I was wearing. The pants roll up easily for packing, and have a UPF of 50. They also hand wash and dry quickly. Two snap closure back pockets and two zippered thigh pockets provide a choice of secure storage.
