



Promising "a better night's sleep and sound masking through science", the Lectro Fan micro is tiny enough to toss in your case if you are predicting a noisy location. This particular model was recommended to me to cancel out the noise of a snoring partner so I do use it at home and now I will certainly take it with me wherever I go, even if I am alone.


This machine generates twenty different sounds with upward facing speakers that fill the room. It includes ten fan sounds and ten white noise variants, precise volume control and has a 60-, 120-, and 180-minute timer.

This unit includes an AC adapter but can also run off a USB power source and is available in white/silver or black.
