## Magellan's Large Display Alarm Clock



Vinyl is back with records being placed in the front of every music store. Analogue watches and clocks aren't far behind. There's something about a travel clock waking you up in an exotic, foreign hotel that rings authentic. Digital vs. analogue – there is no right or wrong. Sleek versus nostalgia. Tradition vs. modern.
